TRIP SAVER can benefit your client if they are required to begin their trip up to three days sooner than originally anticipated, due to a covered unforeseen event.

Example: If a snow storm is coming and an airline has cancelled your client's flight, but the airline can accommodate them on another flight up to three days in advance, the client can take that option and avoid a possible cancellation of their entire trip. The Trip Saver option includes a benefit up to \$2,500 per insured person that may cover additional costs associated with departing earlier to "save" their trip, such as air ticket change fees, transportation, meals and hotel costs.

TRIP EXCHANGE provides coverage for a covered unforeseen event occurring prior to departure, causing your client to modify their trip, rather than cancelling it completely. This could consist of moving the trip dates to a future date and/or rebooking the trip to a new destination.

Example: A hurricane recently hit your client's destination. They can transfer their trip to another destination and may be reimbursed up to 50% of their trip cost, for any charges incurred due to the change, such as air ticket change fees, increased fare costs, transportation and hotel costs.
