

On March 14, 2020 New Zealand's Prime Minister announced that all international arrivals will need to self-isolate for 14-days on arrival, and the new restrictions will be reviewed in 16-days. Furthermore, she also banned the arrival of cruise ships entering New Zealand until June 30. As you can understand, this will impact all passengers traveling to New Zealand in the next few weeks.

We want to reassure you that our team are contacting agents and clients who will be affected to ensure they are aware these changes and are doing everything we can to accommodate the postponement of their arrangements.
